Shatpada: A volatile attractant for trapping uzi fly, *Exorista bombycis*, prasitiod pest on mulberry silkworm Bombyx mori based on pheromonal compounds

• Brand Name: Shatpada Uzi trap

• Material: An attractant mixture with sticky trap

• **Production method:** A attractants are loaded in a polypropylene trap.

• Target pest: Uzi fly, Exorista bombycis

• Method:

Glue traps with attractants are placed in the silkworm rearing house. The flies are attracted to the lure and get stuck to the glue.

• Target states: Karnataka

• **Validation:** The technology is evaluated in silkworm rearing houses at Kolar and Mysuru areas duing 2017 – 2018.

• Benefits:

The attractant with trap helps to produce undamaged cocoons that have good market value.



• Commercialization of technology: The technology is commercialized.
