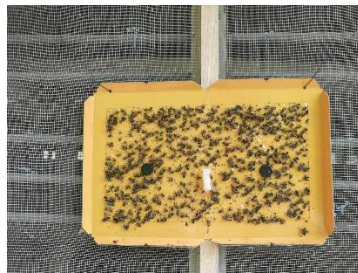


Shatpada: A volatile attractant for trapping uzi fly, *Exorista bombycis*, parasitoid pest on mulberry silkworm *Bombyx mori* based on pheromonal compounds

- **Brand Name: Shatpada Uzi trap**
- **Material:** An attractant mixture with sticky trap
- **Production method:** A attractants are loaded in a polypropylene trap.
- **Target pest:** Uzi fly, *Exorista bombycis*
- **Method:**
Glue traps with attractants are placed in the silkworm rearing house. The flies are attracted to the lure and get stuck to the glue.
- **Target states:** Karnataka
- **Validation:** The technology is evaluated in silkworm rearing houses at Kolar and Mysuru areas duing 2017 – 2018.
- **Benefits:**
The attractant with trap helps to produce undamaged cocoons that have good market value.



- **Commercialization of technology:** The technology is commercialized.
